Promoted by the Chamber Orchestra Association of Pesaro in order to contribute to the promotion of Rossini's genius in the world and to encourage young people to study music seriously and passionately

The CIMP XIX International Music Competition 'Città di Pesaro' takes place in Pesaro on 2/6 May 2022 and is divided into the following Prizes:

Competition online

open to musicians and schools from all over the world

Competition Live

reserved for musicians of any nationality as long as students enrolled in Italian schools or resident in Italy (for foreign candidates it is mandatory to attach the residence permit to the documentation of the application form). This rule is necessary to overcome the measures to combat the spread of the COVID-19 epidemic. However, it will be possible to participate from any country in the world, in streaming mode. The candidate must have an internet connection and a device with camera and microphone. To facilitate the participation of young talents in the auditions of the Competition, in some cities international cultural will be set up CIMP satellites stages equipped with digital devices audio/video.

Art. 1 – REGISTRATIONS AND FEES

Each competitor can subscribe to several sections and to a single category, even higher than that relating to one's age, if the artistic preparation allows it: in this case it is necessary to do so explicit request in the application form. Competitors who have been winners of the Prizes of past editions will not be able to participate in the assignment of the same Prize.

The organization for the realization of the Contest incurs expenses for which it requires the participants a registration fee as indicated in the annexes relating to the Prizes. For the audition in streaming mode the registration fee is equal to that relating to the section and to the category to which they belong. Registration fees will be refunded only in the case in if, for reasons of force majeure, the competition or individual categories should be canceled.

Registration for the Contest can be done **by e-mail to the address concorso@cimp.it** or directly **on the dedicated page on the www.cimp.it website.**

The application must contain the following attached documents, under penalty of exclusion:

- Registration form completed in all its parts (all. 1 – for registrations by e-mail);
- Copy of the identification document (in case of registration for the Live competition identity card certifying the Italian residence or Passport and Italian residence permit or passport);
- Attestation of the receipt of the registration fee;
- Attestation of the payment of a supplementary fee to the registration to request the collaboration of the accompanying pianist made available by the organization.

Each competitor or group must submit their application within the deadlines from the individual Prizes (art. 2).

The payment of the registration fee can be made on the bank account of BPER BANCA Pesaro office (**IBAN: IT92T0538713302000042933011**) payable to: Associazione Orchestra da Camera di Pesaro.

In the particular case of Winners reported by the Juries of past editions registration will not entail the payment of the registration fee.

Art. 2 – **AUDITIONS – CALENDAR**

The detailed timetable for the hearings will be published online on the website www.cimp.it in the two days after the deadline for registrations as required by the regulations. Other information yes they can request the CIMP Secretariat tel. + 39 3312158400 or the email info@cimp.it.

Before starting the Live Auditions, the competitors must show to the Competition Secretariat an identification document and a copy of the document of payment of the fee of participation.

Competitors who will not be present at the call provided for in the calendar of the auditions will be admitted to the auditions only at the sole discretion of the Jury and however, before the closure of the relevant category.

The **Competition Online** will take place in 3 stages:

- registration by 23 April 2022;
- sending videos by 30 April 2022;
- Announcement of winners: 6 May 2022

The **Competition Live** will take place in Pesaro on 2/6 May 2022.

These are the phases:

- registration by 23 April 2022;
- opening of the Live Competition 2 May 2022;
- Gala Concert and awards ceremony: 6 May, 2022

The organization of the Competition provides an accompanist pianist, however it is allowed to provide a personal pianist. In this regard the competitor must send together with the application form the attestation of the payment of a supplementary fee. The secretariat reserves the right to request copies of the bound scores if he recognized the need for it.

The additional fee for the eventual accompanying pianist is € 50 and includes a concertation test, the audition of the competition and the performance at the concert of the winners.

ART. 3 – **THE JURIES**

Different Evaluation Juries will be nominated that will be composed respectively by musicians, teachers, entertainment professionals and renowned scholars, plus a secretary, without the right to vote. The members of the Juries who have in place, or have had relations didactic with candidates for the competition, will abstain from the discussion and evaluation of the same. Each Jury will assign scores expressed in cents according to the criteria established by the Jury itself at the time of settlement. It will be the right of the Jury to interrupt the execution of a competitor or possibly listen to it again.

The Jury will decide to award prizes ex-aequo or not to award them. The decisions of the Juries are final. For the 'Popular Prize' vote will be promoted through LIKE from the www.cimp.it website.

Art. 4 – **SCORES AND AWARDS**

Each Jury will award the Diplomas in the following ways:

- **First Prize:** competitors and ensembles who have obtained a score of not less than 95/100
- **Second Prize:** competitors and ensembles who have obtained a non-existent score less than 90/100
- **Third Prize:** competitors and ensembles who have obtained a score of not less than 85/100
- **Meritorious** will be the competitors and chamber ensembles who have obtained a score not less than 80/100.

The competitor who obtains the highest score among the First Prizes of each category will be awarded the **First Absolute Prize** of the category (list of Prizes in the annexes).

Among the First Absolute Prizes of the category will be awarded the **Pesaro Prize 2022**.

PESARO AWARD

the Prize will be awarded to the Absolute Winner of the Competition City of Pesaro XIX Edition. The Pesaro Prize includes a medal of the city of Pesaro, the Diploma and a Prize of 1000€. The winner will be offered the opportunity to make a professional video recording that will be published on the HalidonMusic YouTube channel within the CIMP project. In addition to the winner will be offered the opportunity to attend a cycle of high specialization lessons at the CIMP Academy of Music of Pesaro

The winners must perform at the Gala Concert that will take place on May 6th at Pesaro. Failure to attend the concert will result in the loss of the Prize assigned.

The names of the winners will be published on the website www.cimp.it.

Each competitor and each non-awarded chamber ensemble will be awarded a Diploma of participation. Participants in the Live sections will receive the Diploma at the end of the hearings; to the participants of the online sections the secretariat of the competition will send the Diplomas by e-mail in PDF format.

Other Prizes and Scholarships may be awarded by the Juries of the various Sections. Lists of Prizes will be published and updated on the Competition website www.cimp.it.

Art. 5 – **HOSPITALITY – INFORMATION**

All Schools, Soloists, Orchestras, Choirs and Groups will be offered guided tours to the City of Pesaro; visits are to be agreed with the organization of the Competition. On the website www.cimp.it you can find some indications of affiliated accommodation facilities. Art. 6 – **ACCEPTANCE CLAUSES**

Registration for the Competition implies the unconditional acceptance of these Rules and the Attachments. The personal data collected by the Pesaro Chamber Orchestra Association will be processed by CIMP as Data Controller in compliance with the current provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 and Legislative Decree no. 196/2003. The organizers reserve the right to verify the veracity of the self-declarations contained in the documentation sent. By registering for the Competition, all rights to use the recordings are transferred, even in streaming, and the release for the publication of the videos in competition on current digital channels and Future. Recordings of performances during auditions or concerts, as well as broadcasts radio or television broadcasts will

not constitute a right for any compensation to the performers. The organizers also reserve the right, for any reasons of force majeure, to make changes to this regulation: in this case they will be communicated promptly to the interested parties. For anything not contemplated in these Regulations, the Competition Management invokes itself every skill. In the event of a dispute, the only legally valid text is the original one.

SCHOOL PRIZE

Annex A to the CIMP Regulation 2022

The School Prize is intended exclusively for students or groups of public or private educational institutions and private or third sector collective bodies such as Bands, Choirs, Associations, Municipal Music Schools, etc.

CATEGORIES AND PROGRAM

The School Prize is divided into the following categories divided by age:

A - Primary schools

- A2. Duo
- A3. Trio
- A4. Chamber Music (4 to 9 elements)
- A5. Orchestra/Choir (10+ elements)

B - Middle schools with a musical address

- B4. Chamber Music (4 to 9 elements)
- B5. Orchestra/Choir (10+ elements)

C - Musical High Schools or High Schools

- C1. Soloists
- C2. Duo
- C3. Trio
- C4. Chamber Music (4 to 9 elements)
- C5. Orchestra/Choir (10+ elements)

D - Conservatories of Music/Universities

- Q1. Soloists
- Q2. Duo
- Q3. Trio
- Q4. Chamber Music (4 to 9 elements)
- Q5. Orchestra/Choir (10+ elements)

E - Musical Institutions (Municipal Schools, Choirs, City Bands, Associations, Academies)

- E1. Soloists
- E2. Duo
- E3. Trio
- E4. Chamber Music (4 to 9 elements)
- E5. Orchestra/Choir (10+ elements)

F - Mixed orchestral and choral formations (to which adult participants do not exceed 50% of the staff)

- F1. Orchestra and choir (from 10 elements upwards)

All participants in categories D and E must be no more than 25 years old. For the Orchestras and Choirs of categories A, B and C, musicians outside the Institution (up to 25 years of age) are allowed to participate for a number not exceeding 1/5 of the staff.

The maximum duration of the hearings is as follows:

A/B: Soloists, Duo, Trio, Chamber Music: 5 minutes; Choir/Orchestra: 15 minutes.

C/D/E: Soloists, Duo, Trio, Chamber Music: 15 minutes; Choir/Orchestra: 20 minutes.

F: Choir/Orchestra : 20 minutes.

The program is free; the pieces presented may be by any author, original, arranged or transcribed. Those who intend to compete for the Rossini International Prize must present a piece by Rossini either in original or transcribed form.

APPLICATION AND REGISTRATION FEE

The application must be received by 23 April 2022.

The application must contain the self-certification signed by a Teacher or Manager certifying the attendance of the competitor and the name of the educational musical institution to which they belong, under penalty of exclusion from the Competition.

The registration fees are determined as follows:

Categories A/B:

Soloists, Duo, Trio, Chamber Music: € 10 per participant; Choir/Orchestra € 5 per participant.

Categories C/D/E/F:

Soloists, Duo, Trio, Chamber Music: €15 per participant; Choir/Orchestra €10 per participant.

The organization provides a collaborating pianist (Articles 1 and 2 of the General Regulations).

MATERIALS

Detailed list of the tools that the organization makes available:

- Digital piano;
- Grand piano;
- 5 keyboards;
- 1 battery;
- 2 amplifiers for electric bass (excluding the jack cables that must be brought independently by the participating schools);
- 3 microphones for solo voice; • overview microphones.

Any other tool or accessory must be provided by the participants.

An audio service will take care of the necessary connections in accordance with what is indicated in the technical sheet to be attached to the application form. AWARDS

There will be category prizes for a total of € 1,000 which will be awarded on the unquestionable opinion of the Jury.

SCHOOL PRIZE Award

the Prize will be awarded to the Absolute Winner of the School Prize Competition. It includes the School Prize Cup, the Diploma and a Prize of 500€. the Winner will be invited to participate in the Città di Pesaro Live Competition, as a candidate admitted to the Final phase open to the public, which will take place in Pesaro on May 6, 2022 and will be able to compete for the Final Prizes of the Competition.

The winner will participate in the Gala Concert at the Teatro Rossini in Pesaro, Saturday, May 7, 2022.

PESARO AWARD

CATEGORIES AND PROGRAM

The City of Pesaro Award is divided into the following categories divided by age:

A - Piano

- A1. up to 10 years old;
- A2. up to 15 years old;
- A3. up to 18 years old;
- A4. up to 30 years old.

B - Opera Singing

- B1. male voices up to the age of 23;
- B2. male voices up to the age of 35;
- B3. female voices up to the age of 23;
- B4. female voices up to the age of 35.

C - Winds

- C1. up to 12 years of age;
- C2. up to 18 years old;
- C3. up to 30 years old.

D: - Strings

- Q1. up to 12 years of age;
- D.2. up to the age of 18;
- Q 3. up to 30 years of age.

E - Chamber Music

All formations from the duo onwards, up to 11 elements, with the exception of formations that include two pianos.

- E1. up to the age of 20;
- E 2. without age limits.

F - Popular Music

The Section wants to give space to the instruments and repertoires of the popular tradition.

- F1. Soloists without age limits;
- F2. Groups without age restrictions.

The program is free and the songs presented can be of any author as long as published with the exception of the category of Chamber and Popular Music where you can present songs also arranged or transcribed. Candidates must specify the piece that will be performed for the Final Phase if they are among the Category Winners. The piece, with a maximum duration of 5 minutes, will be an integral part of the program and must also be performed during the audition.

Those who intend to compete at rossini International must present a repertoire dedicated to Gioachino Rossini chosen from the original compositions, transcriptions or unpublished compositions dedicated to him.

The maximum duration of the hearings is as follows:

A - Piano A1: 5 minutes; A2: 10 minutes; A3: 20 minutes; A4: 40 minutes.

Execution from memory is mandatory.

B - Opera singing B1: 20 minutes; B2 : 30 minutes; B3: 20 minutes; B3 : 30 minutes.

The Program must include three Opera Arias, one of which is at least in Italian.

C - Winds C1: 10 minutes; C2: 20 minutes; C3: 30 minutes.

D - Strings D1: 10 minutes; D.2: 20 minutes; D 3: 30 minutes.

E - Chamber Music E.1: 15 minutes; E2: 30 minutes.

The pieces presented can be taken from the original repertoire, or transcribed.

F - Popular Music F.1: 15 minutes; F2: 30 minutes.

The pieces presented can be taken from the original repertoire, transcribed, arranged and performed with tools of popular origin.

APPLICATION AND REGISTRATION FEE

The application must be received by 23 April 2022.

The registration fees are determined as follows:

The winner will be invited to Pesaro for the Concert from the Balcony of Casa Rossini on the occasion of the 2023 edition of the City of Pesaro Competition and will be reported for other Concerts within the CIMP programming.

In addition, the winner will be offered the opportunity to attend a cycle of high specialization lessons at the CIMP Academy of Music of Pesaro.

TEBALDI GRAND PRIX PESARO

the Prize will be awarded to a young Soprano. The Winner will receive a Cup, diploma and Prize of 500€. The winner will be reported for Concerts organized on the occasion of the centenary of the birth of the great Soprano. In addition, the winner will be offered the opportunity to make a registration professional video that will be published on the HalidonMusic YouTube channel within the CIMP project and will be offered the opportunity to attend a cycle of high specialization lessons at the CIMP Academy of Music of Pesaro.

The winner of the Tebaldi Grand Prix Pesaro will go directly to the Semifinal phase of the next edition of the Renata Tebaldi International Voice Competition, organized by Renata Tebaldi Foundation in the Republic of San Marino.

PAVAROTTI GRAND PRIX PESARO

the Prize will be awarded to a young Tenor. The winner will receive a Cup, diploma and a Prize of 500€. The winner will be offered the opportunity to make a professional video recording that will be published on the HalidonMusic YouTube channel within the CIMP project. The winner will be invited to Pesaro for Concerts within the CIMP program. In addition to the winner will be offered the opportunity to attend a cycle of high specialization lessons at the CIMP Academy of Music of Pesaro.

PREMIO UGOLINI

It is awarded to the best Pianist in competition and consists of the Diploma and the opportunity to attend a cycle of high specialization lessons at the CIMP Academy of Music of Pesaro.

PREMIO PEZZOPANE

It is awarded to the best Opera Singer in Competition and consists of the Diploma and the opportunity to attend a cycle of high specialization lessons at the CIMP Academy of Music of Pesaro.

PREMIO ESPOSITO

It is awarded to the best brass in the Competition and consists of the Diploma and the opportunity to attend a cycle of high specialization lessons at the CIMP Academy of Music of Pesaro.

CIMP ONLINE

Annex D

The online CIMP auditions take place online through the presentation of a video.

CATEGORIES AND PROGRAM

The CIMP online is divided into the following categories divided by age:

S – Soloists

S1: up to 12 years old;

S2: up to 18 years old;

S3: up to 30 years old.

O – Orchestras/Choirs/Mixed Ensembles

O1: Orchestras

- O2: Choirs
- O3: Bands
- O4: Mixed Organics

K – Popular Prize

Only one category

The music program is free. For competitors who wish to participate in the assignment of the Bring Your Rossini Prize it is mandatory to insert a song dedicated to Gioachino Rossini.

APPLICATION AND REGISTRATION FEE

The application must be received by 23 April 2022.

After registering for the Competition, the secretariat will send each member a pdf document, containing the CIMP logo and the identification code of the interpreter. This document must be printed and inserted in the video to be recorded (framing of a physical sheet containing the initials and the CIMP logo also transcribed manually), under penalty of exclusion from the competition.

The registration fee is 10 € for each video (art. 1 and 2 of the general regulation).

VIDEO MATERIALS

Each competitor may submit only one video in the Competition.

The video in competition, with a maximum duration of 15 minutes, must be recorded without any interruption (under penalty of exclusion). The video for Popular Prize must be only 5 minutes.

The deadline to submit your video is set by Saturday, 30 April, 2022. The video must be recorded exclusively in file format (.mov / .mpg2 / .mpg4 / h264) and sent to the Competition Secretariat via online transfer services such as WeTransfer, Mega or sharing such as DropBox and Google Drive.

The video must include:

- the video presentation of the performer or the director of the performance in Italian or English (My name is..., I live in ..., I have years, I perform....)
- the complete performance of the musical piece without cuts or montages;
- the framing of all the musicians or artists taking part in the performance;
- **clearly visible framing of the pdf document containing the CIMP logo and the identification code of the interpreter;**

To participate in the assignment of the Bring your Rossini Award, the theme of the video is bound: "Gioachino Rossini for me is...". Participants will have to present their idea of Rossini freely using the content they want. The artistic form can be free and can include any creative message (music, opera, film, mime, dance, cartoons, figurative arts, cooking, ...).

The videos registered will be published on the youtube channel of the CIMP Concorso Internazionale Musicale Pesaro and on the facebook pages dedicated #CIMPonline and #BringyourRossini.

Popular voting will be promoted via LIKE on the [CIMP online page 2021 edition – YouTube](#) for Section 'Popular Prize'.
